Memorial of a Deed bearing date the Fifth day of October one thousand eight hundred and forty three whereby Patrick Fowlow of Trinity de of an hand for and in consideration of the sum of One Shilling current money when in hand paid the receipt whereof is acknowledged did grant bargain and sell unto the Reverend Henry James Fitzgerald Rector of Trinity the Reverend James Norris Malyon Minister Robert Bayly William Nelson Francis C. Keptura Alexander Bremner and Benjamin Sweetland Esquires a Board of Education for the District of Trinity and to their successors in Office as such Board of Commissioners duly appointed "All that piece or parcel of Land situate and being on the north side of Trinity near the Cross way whereon is now a School House in a unfinished state and also an additional piece of Land adjoining thereto of the space of Twenty feet in a direct line with the fence of the first lot and thence out to the public Road leaving a sufficient space for a Gate to Patrick Fowlows Field as descnted in the Diagram thereto annexed" To have and to hold unto the said Reverend Henry James Fitzgerald and other Commissioners of the Board of Education as aforesaid and their successors in Office as aforesaid for the use of the said School for ever.
