by land owned by aforesaid John F. Wheeler by which it extends 5 chains and 64 links and on the west by the aforesaid William Fields land by which it extends 5 chains and 80 links being more particularly shown in the annexed Diagram containing an area of 2 acres 2 roods and 13 perches more or less.
